

Welcome all examinees to the CU Test of English Proficiency.

Listen carefully to complete your computer answer-sheet form.

Use a pen to write down all the information.

In the top right hand corner of your answer sheet, there is a box for you to write your seat number. You will find your seat number on your test ticket.

Now to complete the rest of the form:

The test date is today's date.

The test time, building name and room number are on your test ticket.

Print your first name and last name neatly in capital letters.

Use a 2B pencil to blacken your gender: Male or Female.

Sign your name in English.

To write your registration number, start on the first box on your left.

If you do not have your registration number, ask for it from the invigilator when he or she comes around to let you sign your name on the name list.

Use your 2B pencil to blacken the circles of your registration number.

Now that you have completed the computer answer-sheet form, listen to the test instructions.

The CU Test of English Proficiency consists of three parts: listening, reading, and writing.

There are 30 items in the listening part. You will have 30 minutes to complete this part.

There are 60 items in the reading part. You will have 70 minutes to complete this part.

There are 30 items in the writing part. The time allowed for this section is 30 minutes.

You will start with the listening part, followed by the reading part and then the writing part.

Each part of the test will be collected when the time for that section is up. So, you will need to have blackened all your choices in each part before the time is up.

Please follow the regulations strictly.

1. Do not open the test paper until you are allowed to do so.
2. You are not allowed to take any test papers or answer sheets out of the exam room.
3. You are not allowed to leave the room before the time is up
4. Do not leave the room until the invigilators have collected all the test papers and answer sheets and allow you to leave the room.
5. If you cheat or give evidence of an attempt to cheat, you will be blacklisted and will not be allowed to take the test again for two years.
